Notice to: Parents/Guardians

Re: Written Annual Notification for Expected Pest Management Products in the Claremont Unified School District

To meet the requirements of the Healthy Schools Act of 2000, the Claremont Unified School District is required to provide annual written notification to parents, guardians and staff regarding the intended applications of pest management materials. For the current school year, the Claremont Unified School District may apply pest management materials as necessity dictates. Please see the reverse for a complete listing. The list is a comprehensive list of products that may be used. Products are only used when necessary—not all products are used in any given year.

All of the materials are fully registered for use in California by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the California EPA. For additional information on pest management materials, you may access the California EPA, Department of Pesticide Regulation, website at www.cdpr.ca.gov/docs/school/schmenu.htm. The District will post warning signs at each area of the school where pesticides will be applied. These signs will be posted 24 hours in advance. However, there may be emergency conditions that require immediate application of pesticides such as an infestation in a classroom. The District will make every effort to notify you of such applications should an emergency occur.

The Claremont Unified School District has implemented an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) system that focuses on long-term prevention or suppression by using non-chemical methods for controlling pest populations to the maximum extent possible. Chemical pesticides are used as a means of pest control only after monitoring indicates that the pest populations have exceeded pre-established thresholds. Pesticides used for any given use are those that present the least hazard to human health and are used in a manner that minimizes risk.

The following dates have been scheduled for pesticide applications should the need exist. All other pesticide applications will on an emergency basis only. **Please keep these dates for your records.**
